At the conclusion of our meeting on December 10, 1999, one of the outstanding items was the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) acceptance criteria with respect to facilities used to store safeguards/classified information. Enclosed is an NRC document entitled "Standard Practice Procedures Plan: Standard Format and Content for the Protection of Classified Matter for NRC Licensee, Certificate Holder, and Others Regulated by the Commission" dated October 1999, that includes the NRC's acceptance criteria referred to at the December 10 meeting.

The document also provides guidance concerning the format and content of the classified matter protection plan to be submitted by Duke Cogema Stone & Webster as part of the license application.
