Dear Mr. Hastings:

U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff plan to review portions of the U.S. Department of Energy's (DOE's) Surplus Plutonium Disposition (SPD) Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS). NRC's review will focus on the mixed oxide (MOX) fuel fabrication facility sections of the SPD FEIS. This review is intended to determine how much of the FEIS NRC can adopt for its EIS for the MOX fuel fabrication facility license process and to discover if there are any areas that need more information. NRC intends to complete this general review in March 2000, and will then provide Duke COGEMA Stone & Webster (DCS) with the results of the review. We trust these results will aid DCS in developing the environmental report to accompany the MOX fuel fabrication facility license application.
