
Dear Sir:

The license application for the Private Fuel Storage Facility (PSFS) identifies the TranStor Storage Cask System as one of the two canister-based storage systems for use at PSFS. On January 10, 2000, BNFL Fuel Solutions Corporation (BFS), the vendor of the TranStor system, wrote to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) to request that NRC cease review of the TranStor storage system license application and return the application to BFS. At an NRC public meeting on March 9, 2000, BFS stated that it would provide supplemental information for the TranStor system.

In light of these actions by BFS, Private Fuel Storage requests that the NRC suspend any further licensing activity regarding the TranStor Storage Cask System in the current proceeding under Docket No. 72-22.
