

Dear Mr. Secretary:

I would like to attend the NRC meetings of June 19 and June 30 and in less than five minutes at the Sheraton Hotel in Salt Lake and the High School in Tooele speak of the effect of what if Utah does not get this opportunity of storage of sent nuclear fuel. I believe that this is an opportunity for both Tooele County and Box Elder County. I support the efforts of PFS in NRC Application No. 72-22 and Pigeon Spur in NRC License Application NRC No. 72-23.

I understand that today's demand for SNF storage in the United States electrical generation industry is 70,000 metric tons. Hence, both PFS and Pigeon Spur facilities are needed to meet all of today's demands for storage of SNF. If both projects are done, delivery can be made via Pigeon Spur and we can keep all rail shipment off of the Wasatch Front.

For half a decade Utah's Governor Michael O. Leavitt has been outspoken against storage of spent nuclear fuel (SNF) in Utah. This is unfortunately kept many responsible people from stepping forward and giving rightful and honest views. We need honest information and fair leadership. Mr. Leavitt needs to keep his politics out of this Federal matter.
