SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF MAY 25, 2000, MEETING (DOCKET 72-22)

Dear Mr. Parkyn:

Enclosed is a summary of the meeting held May 25, 2000, between the staff of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and representatives of Private Fuel Storage, Limited Liability Company (PFS). The purpose of the meeting was to discuss, clarify, and establish a schedule for closure of a number of open items associated with the staff's completion of its safety review of the PFS application for a license to receive, transfer, and possess power reactor spent fuel and other radioactive material associated with spent fuel storage at an away-from-reactor independent spent fuel storage installation (ISFSI).

The two major categories of the open items are issues associated with (1) demonstrating the stability of the foundations of the storage pads and the canister transfer building and (2) military aircraft use of air space near the proposed PFS facility. NRC staff believes that significant progress was made toward resolution of these open items. PFS representatives indicated that PFS would be able to provide all outstanding information to the NRC staff by June 30, 2000. The NRC staff stresses that this is the latest date that new information can be submitted for the staff's review if the staff is to complete its safety evaluation report by September 30, 2000.
