ORDER

Prior to today's order, the Scientists for a Secure Waste Storage (SSWS) had served a Notice of Appeal and Brief on the Secretary of the Commission by U.S. mail, first class and served the parties by electronic mail. To avoid confusion, the Commission will accept any responses to the SSWS appeal that are filed by May 18, 1998.

In view of this order, henceforth the five-day grace period for answering pleadings served by first-class mail shall not be applicable. See 10 C.F.R. §§ 2.710, 2.712. In addition, to avoid


