ORDER

(Ruling on Discovery and Summary  
Disposition Time Extension Filings)

Upon consideration of (1) intervenor Ohngo Gaudadeh Devia's (OGD) June 2, 1999 motion to defer action on its May 27, 1999 motion to compel applicant Private Fuel Storage, L.L.C., (PFS) to respond to OGD's May 10, 1999 discovery requests; and (2) the NRC staff's June 3, 1999 motion for extension of time to file its response to the PFS May 19, 1999 motion for summary disposition on contention Utah H, it is

ORDERED, that (1) the OGD June 2, 1999 motion to defer action on its motion to compel is granted; (2) OGD shall file a statement with the Board on or before Wednesday, June 9, 1999, specifying what portions of its May 27 motion to compel no longer require Board action; and (3) PFS shall

file its response regarding any portions of the OGD motion to compel still at issue within seven days of the date upon which the OGD statement of matters not in controversy is filed;<sup>1</sup> and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that (1) the staff's June 3, 1999 motion for extension of time to respond to the PFS May 19, 1999 motion for summary disposition on contention Utah H is granted; (2) the staff and intervenor State of Utah (State) shall have up to and including Friday, June 25, 1999, within which to file responses to the PFS summary disposition motion;<sup>2</sup> and (3) responses opposing responses supporting the motion shall be filed on or before Friday, July 9, 1999.

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<sup>1</sup> This response deadline is in line with the response period established in the Board's general directive regarding discovery motions. See Licensing Board Memorandum and Order (Additional General Schedule Guidance and Informal Discovery Status Conference Schedule) (Aug. 20, 1998) at 4 (unpublished). Such a seven-day period also would be applicable to any OGD response to the PFS motion, filed this date, to quash the deposition of Leon Bear.

<sup>2</sup> In its motion, the staff represents that the State requests a similar extension of time to file its response to the PFS motion, which PFS opposes absent a showing of good cause that it asserts has not been made. See NRC Staff's Motion for Extension of Time to File Response to [PFS] Motion for Summary Disposition (Contention H) (June 3, 1999) at 3. PFS's point normally would be well taken. In this instance, however, the rule governing summary disposition responses contemplates simultaneous filings by those opposing and supporting the motion. See 10 C.F.R. § 2.749(a). As a consequence, in the absence of any apparent reason why the rule's filing sequence should not be observed, we grant the State (which it is reasonable to assume will oppose the PFS motion) a similar extension.

The filings permitted under this order should be served on the Board, the Office of the Secretary, and counsel for the other participants by facsimile transmission, e-mail, or other means that will ensure receipt by midnight Eastern Time (ET) on the day of filing. See Licensing Board Memorandum and Order (Initial Prehearing Order) (Sept. 23, 1997) at 5-6 (unpublished); Licensing Board Memorandum and Order (Additional Guidance on Service Procedures) (Nov. 19, 1997) (unpublished); Licensing Board Memorandum and Order (Schedule for Telephone Conference and Directives Regarding Expedited Service) (Sept. 2, 1998) at 2-3 (unpublished).

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
