Dear Mr. Mulligan:

This letter acknowledges the receipt of your views that you provided by electronic mail (E-mail) dated June 14, 2000. Your message discussed two examples, one at Vermont Yankee in 1991, and another at Kewaunee in June 2000, where an inadequately sized service water discharge header could have affected the operability of the emergency diesel generators (EDGs) in certain circumstances. We have reviewed the information you have provided and have discussed it with NRC representatives in the applicable regional offices for consideration for inclusion in our assessment process. In addition, this information has been provided to the Events Assessments and Generic Communications Branch of the office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation. As part of their normal oversight process, this branch reviews all industry events for consideration of possible generic implications.

We appreciate you taking the time and effort to convey your concerns to us.
