THE REASON FOR THE VIOLATION

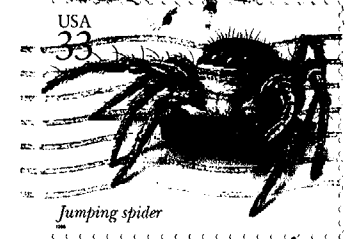
I THOUGHT THE RADIOACTIVITY WAS FROM
