TEST RESULTS

WCNOC Employees

One Wolf Creek Nuclear Operating Corporation (WCNOC) employee tested positive for cocaine on follow-up test. This was the individual's second confirmed positive drug test for cocaine which resulted in removal from unescorted access to protected areas and activities within the scope of 10 CFR 26 for a minimum of three years from the date of removal.

One WCNOC employee tested in the alcohol buffer zone (.020 - .039) on a random test. The individual's supervisor was contacted and informed of the result and the employee returned to his work assignments.

Contractors

One contractor tested positive for marijuana and amphetamines on a pre-access screen. The individual's unescorted access was denied.
