SUBJECT: SOUTH TEXAS PROJECT, UNITS 1 AND 2 - TIMELINE FOR COMPLETION
OF REVIEW OF RISK-INFORMED EXEMPTION REQUESTS FROM SPECIAL
TREATMENT REQUIREMENTS (TAC NOS. MA6057 AND MA6058)

Dear Mr. Cottle:

The purpose of this letter is to share with you our timeline for the completion of our review of your risk-informed exemption requests from the special treatment requirements of 10 CFR Parts 21, 50, and 100. During the June 20 - 21, 2000, meeting, your staff provided us with its thoughts on the timeline for completion of our actions regarding your requests. Your staff indicated that we should be able to make our decisions by the middle of January 2001. We have considered your comments and established our timeline for performing our review as outlined in the enclosure. As we discussed with your staff, most recently at the July 24 - 25, 2000, public meeting, we have concluded that we should be able to complete our review of your exemption requests by April 15, 2001. Meeting this date is linked to the ability of both of us to meet the interim milestones outlined in the enclosure. These interim milestones were shared with your staff during the July 2000 meeting.

You will note that some of the interim milestones include actions that you need to perform. The first such milestone is your formal response to our January 18, 2000, request for additional information (RAI) and a revised exemption request submittal. In order for us to move forward with your exemption requests, we requested at the July 2000 meeting that you respond to the January 18, 2000, RAI, and provide the staff with revised exemption requests. You were asked to base your formal response and revised submittal on the draft review guidelines we forwarded to you on July 19, 2000, telephone conferences on RAI questions, and the series of meetings we have held to date.

Based on subsequent discussions with your staff, we understand that you may need to slip the completion of this action from August 15, 2000, to August 31, 2000. This may introduce some delay in the completion of some of our future actions. However, we anticipate that working together, we should be able to minimize the delay in issuing our final decisions regarding your exemption requests. In order for us to minimize the delay, it is important for your revised submittal to be sufficiently detailed to allow us to prepare our draft safety evaluation. We have discussed the level of detail that we need with your staff at the meetings we have recently held. We anticipate that we should still be able to complete our reviews and

issue our decisions on your requests by April 15, 2001. Insufficient detail in your response, or delays in your ability to meet the dates for interim milestones, will have a direct impact on the completion date for the exemption requests.
