I am responding to your request for a current organizational listing of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC) facilities that are required to submit Affirmative Employment Plans (AEP) and reports pursuant to Management Directive 714 (MD-714). The NRC submits an Agency-wide AEP and accomplishment report to EEOC which incorporates affirmative employment plans and accomplishments of our headquarters and regional offices. The NRC's AEP was initially issued in November 1998 outlining our equal employment opportunity and diversity goals for fiscal years FY 1999 - FY 2003. A copy of the Plan was submitted to your office on February 23, 1999. The Plan will be updated in the near future to reflect changes in demographic data and objectives.

The NRC organization consists of a headquarters office and four regional offices totaling 2798 full-time permanent employees. A break out of each office location and the current number of employees is listed below:
