In a letter dated September 17, 1999 (Serial No. 99-002A), Virginia Electric and Power Company (Virginia Power) resubmitted its response to Generic Letter (GL) 96-05 on periodic verification of design-basis capability of safety-related motor-operated valves. The NRC requested additional information based on that submittal in a letter dated January 6, 2000. Virginia Power responded to that request for additional information in a letter dated February 28, 2000 (Serial No. 00-013). In that response, Virginia Power committed to provide the NRC with a date for final implementation of the JOG interim program and risk ranking.
