



Dear NRC Chairman Richard Meserve:

The formal hearing process that is used in all other NRC plant
licensings should be the same for the proposed repository at Yucca
Mountain. Changing to an informal process:

(1) gives the appearance that the NRC is doing favors for the
DOE, and (2) an informal process will seriously erode the public
confidence in the licensing process and the ability
of the NRC to regulate.
