Dear Judge Bollwerk,

I am writing in opposition to the Goshute Skull Valley nuclear waste storage facility. Our citizens deserve and demand more time than is legally mandated by law to study the Draft Environment Impact Study. I request an additional six month extension period be granted so that Utahns have enough time to review the DEIS, to hold public forums and educational sessions and create necessary dialogue for citizens.

The licensing process has failed to disclose pertinent information regarding risk factors on the transportation corridors, information regarding emergency preparedness and information regarding what will be done to assure the stability of this long-term nuclear waste facility.

If we can't be provided with this information, the NRC must deny licensure of this facility.

I would also ask that the safety records of the companies comprising

Private fuel storage be examined thoroughly. Before they can assure the safety of transporting 40,000 metric tons of nuclear waste through communities across the nation, they should first be able to demonstrate a proven safety record that is flawless. There is no room for error with nuclear waste. They also must be able to prove their readiness to handle any accident or unexpected disaster -- an impossibility. The DOE predicts 15 accidents annually of trucks carrying this waste. Can they also predict the consequences of exposure to undetermined amounts of radiation? And who pays for such spills? Of particular concern is that private shipments do not have the same requirements as government controlled shipments.

There are far too many unanswered questions here. We must have now time to get the answers. We will not once again be a "low use segment of the population" as we were deemed during atomic testing. We have lived with the awful legacy of radiation, we will not repeat that miserable experiment.




