Enter your comments: I am writing to express my strong opposition to granting right of way of Private Fuel Storage (PFS) to build a rail line on public land leading to the Goshute Indian Reservation.

Have we learned nothing in the past 50 years of experimenting with elements that we cannot neutralize? We moved forward with Nuclear Energy without long-term data to realize the outcome of our actions. We started using the energy without knowing how to absolutely prevent accidents in the power plant facilities.
