
Dear Mr. Meyer:

The plans to use the Goshute Indian tribe in Skull Valley, Utah, as a nuclear refuse storage facility is something that must be stopped. I am a resident of Salt Lake City and am appalled that these materials will be transported through this state and stored less than 50 miles from Salt Lake City. The actual agreement between the Goshute Indian tribe and PFS seems corrupt and should be investigated.

Please consider the safety and long term affects on the state of Utah if these plans are approved. I believe that if the residents of this state were more informed on this subject, public outrage would occur.
