Good Morning,

Thank you for your quick response to our letter. The process that we will undertake regarding your certificates is called "transferring the certificates to inactive status." You correctly identified 13.4 as the applicable section. In short, the definition of an inactive certificate is one that can no longer be newly distributed. Unless the certificate was issued in error, we do not terminate or remove the certificate completely. Doing this would remove record of the previous existence of the product. By maintaining an inactive certificate, if a question comes up in the future regarding the product, it can still be located in the Registry of Sealed Source and Device Evaluations, and the background file associated with the certificate can be referenced. In view of this, we still would like to obtain the information listed in our letter to you. Once a certificate is made inactive, there is less chance that the documents describing the product will be available, and part of the process of making the certificate inactive is to ensure that all necessary information is in the file prior to completing what may be our last contact with the distributor. If you need additional time in which to provide the requested information, please let me know and we can arrange that.
