Mr. Buckman,

There are three registrations in the past for the Series 5245 devices: 8/3/92, a copy of which is in the 'Original' section of your application; 6/22/95, copies of which, with cover letter are in the 'Received' section of your application; and the 5/30/97 version which is attached, with its cover letter. The 5/30/97 version is also available from the NRC website under our Office of State and Tribal Programs at: <http://www.hsr.doe.gov/nrc/ssdr/03750102.pdf>. This section can be accessed by selecting 'Materials' from the main page, www.nrc.gov, then, 'Nuclear Materials Licensed by Agreement States', and finally, 'Device registry (SS&D)'. The registrations are listed alphabetically by the holder's name and by registration number.

The basic sequence, as well as I can tell, was:

8/3/92	Initial issue of registration to IMS, only 5245-01 on it (<i>copy in 'Original' section</i>)
3/1/95	IMS requests amendments, 10 in all, 2 page letter (<i>copy in 'Original' section</i>)
6/22/95	NRC issues amended registration (5245-03 for Beth Steel) with cover letter detailing which amendments were granted and why, and asks additional questions to IMS in order to work on remaining amendment requests - <i>copy in your application 'Received' section</i>
3/21/96	NRC letter requesting IMS response to 6/22/95 letter - <i>copy in 'Received' section</i>
4/19/96	IMS response to 6/22/95 letter - <i>copy in 'Sent' section</i>
5/28/97	Reviewer note to record which provides some information on how he granted additional amendments to registration - <i>attached</i>
5/30/97	Registration amended - <i>attached</i>
6/5/97	Registration issued with cover letter explaining that remaining amendment requests are voided - <i>attached</i>
6/2000	IMS Systems, Inc. application initiated

Please note that the existing registration, 5/30/97, only authorized the 5245-03 gauge for Bethlehem Steel. No other installations are authorized. Due to time constraints, the application we are discussing will likely only be for the 5245-02 gauge for the North Carolina facility. With this in mind, I still need two pieces of information, the number of ionization chambers for the 5245-02 gauge (for Table I), and the name/city of the the North Carolina facility which has the 5245-02 gauge.

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
