The purpose of this letter is to revise the proposed change to the physical security plan which was previously submitted in the License Amendment Request dated March 10, 2000. This letter supersedes the November 6, 2000, followup letter. The followup letter was due to teleconference calls with the NRC Security Reviewer A. Tardiff, on October 26 and October 31, 2000. An error was made in the wording which was added to that letter. The NRC Reviewer was notified of this error on November 9, 2000. TVA has evaluated these changes and has determined that the changes do not effect the No Significant Hazards evaluation which was submitted in the March 10, 2000 letter.
