
Mr. Egan is in the process of moving Egan & Associates' primary office from the District of Columbia to Reston, Virginia. Mr. Egan has accordingly submitted an application for

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admission to the bar of the Commonwealth of Virginia, and such application has been approved by the Virginia Board of Bar Examiners. However, due to the demands of a recent trial in Texas, Mr. Egan was unable to be sworn in to the Virginia bar in Richmond this autumn, and, because such ceremonial sessions occur only intermittently, will not be sworn in until January 2001. Thus, Mr. Egan maintains his office in the District of Columbia for the purpose of actual client representation and client meetings in the practice of law, but has moved his administrative operations to Reston. Since Mr. Egan now spends most of his time in the Reston office, the Reston phone and fax numbers were provided. Mr. Egan's landlord provides him with office space in both the District of Columbia and in Reston. Upon completion of the swearing in ceremony in Virginia, Mr. Egan intends to close his District of Columbia offices.

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
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
