SUBJECT: SALEM NUCLEAR GENERATING STATION, UNIT NOS. 1 AND 2 -
AUXILIARY BUILDING VENTILATION SYSTEM, POTENTIAL
UNFILTERED RELEASES (TAC NO. MA8267)

On February 26, 2000, TAC No. MA8267 was initiated to document the task of resolving concerns that remained with the technical staff associated with the Salem Nuclear Generating Station (Salem) Auxiliary Building Ventilation System. These concerns were identified in a memorandum from John N. Hannon to Elinor G. Adensam, dated January 14, 2000. One approach envisioned to address the concerns raised in the memorandum was a possible Task Interface Agreement (TIA) with Region I.

On November 29, 2000, members from the Plant Systems Branch and Project Directorate I met to discuss whether the TIA was an appropriate mechanism to address the concerns. During the meeting it was determined that the TIA approach was not the most effective means to address the staff's questions and that TAC MA8267 be closed-out. It was agreed that the staff pursue any further concerns or questions as a part of its review of Technical Specifications changes submitted by PSEG Nuclear LLC in response to Generic Letter 99-02 (TAC Nos. MA9105 and MA9106).
