Defueled Emergency Plan Revision 4

The purpose of this letter is to inform the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) that Connecticut Yankee Atomic Power Company (CYAPCO) has implemented Revision 4 to the Haddam Neck Plant Defueled Emergency Plan, effective December 1, 2000.

The primary changes to Revision 4 are as follows:

1. The positions of the Operations Shift Manager (OSM) and Emergency Director (ED) have been combined. The previous Emergency Plan required the on-call ED to relieve the OSM upon activation of the Defueled Emergency Response Organization. Revision 4 has the OSM remain in the position of ED and continue to direct all emergency requirements to plant personnel and equipment.
2. The former Emergency Operations Center personnel decontamination facility was replaced with another facility inside the plant.
3. The new NRC telephone service provider (MCI WorldCom – FTS2001) is reflected in the plan as a result of NRC Regulatory Issue Summary 2000-11, NRC Emergency Telecommunication System.

CYAPCO has reviewed the revisions in accordance with 10CFR50.54(q), the requirements of 10CFR50 Appendix E, and the exemptions previously granted as part of the defueled emergency plan. CYAPCO has determined that the revisions do not decrease the effectiveness of the plan.


