Comments: At the point 3.17.4.2.2.1 Individual Doses Estimates:

"The plan skin thickness is approximately ... 0.25 cm of structural steel ..."

J think this is incorrect. The skin of the aircraft is only of aluminium and plastic. Steel exists only in structural elements (longerons, spars, ...) and cannot be a shield for crews and passengers.

The resulting annual individual EDE for crew and passengers may be higher than in table 3.17.4.
