I. Memorandum and Order in Response to 2.206 Petition on Yankee
Rowe Nuclear Power Station (COMSECY-91-007)

The Commission, by a 4-0 vote, approved an order (attached) responding to a June 4, 1991, petition, as subsequently supplemented, filed by the Union of Concerned Scientists and the New England Coalition on Nuclear Pollution (hereinafter "Petitioners") seeking emergency enforcement action and requesting a public hearing with the Commission seeking the immediate shutdown of the Yankee Rowe nuclear power plant. The order denies the requested immediate shutdown and specifies certain actions to be taken by the licensee and NRC staff in order for the licensee to continue operations until April 1992.

(Subsequently, on July 31, 1991, the Secretary signed and issued the Order as CLI-91-11.)
