**CORRECTION TO DECLARATION OF  
GEORGE WAGNER AND DAVID GIRMAN**

Applicant Private Fuel Storage, L.L.C. ("Applicant") hereby files a correction to the Declaration of George Wagner and David Girman (Dec. 30, 2000), which was filed in support of Applicant's Motion for Summary Disposition of Utah Contention K and Confederated Tribes Contention B (Dec. 30, 2000). Paragraph 25 of the declaration should be corrected as follows, with new text underlined and old text struck through:

25. The locations of the cruise missile crash sites on the UTTR over the last 10 years are listed on Table 1 in the Cruise Missile Report. None of the missiles crashed within 10 nautical miles of the PFSF site. The closest crash location is 183 miles to the southwest. Another crashed 18 miles from the site and the remainder impacted over 30 miles from the PFSF, with the most distant 115 miles to the southwest. Assuming a nominal missile ground speed of 420 knots, the nearest cruise missile impact location was almost at least 2 1/2 minutes flying time from the PFSF site. This is a long time considering that an FTS can be activated nearly instantaneously. As discussed above, according to Col. Lightfoot at the UTTR and the 49<sup>th</sup> Test Squadron at Barksdale AFB, the cruise missile crashes on the UTTR impacted the ground within at most half a mile of the planned missile flight path.

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
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
