SUBJECT: TOUR AND FOLLOW-UP VISITS TO SKULL VALLEY

Dear Chairman Bear:

I am writing to request the permission of the Skull Valley Band of Goshute Indians for the group listed below to visit your reservation to tour the site of the proposed Private Fuel Storage, L.L.C. (PFS) independent spent fuel storage installation (ISFSI) and to allow our support contractors from Oak Ridge National Laboratories (ORNL) to gather some preliminary information for the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) which the staff must prepare as part of the licensing process. In addition to staff from the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and ORNL, staff from the Center for Nuclear Waste Regulatory Analyses (CNWRA), which is assisting in the safety review of the PFS license application, would also be on the tour. The CNWRA is NRC's federally funded research and development center. The tour is planned for June 2, 1998.

We also request permission to allow two members of the ORNL staff (accompanied by one or two members of the NRC staff) to perform limited observations of the proposed ISFSI site and surrounding area on the morning of June 3, 1998, for the purpose of gathering geological information and information regarding local plant and animal life for input into the EIS. A list of specific activities which we request permission to conduct on June 3, 1998 (and the names of the participants) will be provided to you within the next 2 weeks.
