RE: SPENT FUEL STORAGE INSTALLATION -- SKULL VALLEY RESERVATION

Statement:

Women Concerned/Utahns United are opposed to the "temporary" site for the storage of nuclear-waste on property belonging to the Goshute group, we believe this is a "bad neighbor" idea.

The 820-acre "temporary" facility is opposed not only by the State of Utah, the people of Utah, grass-roots organizations but also by groups of the Goshutes.

The "temporary" site is arguable and the transportation of spent nuclear fuel to this site is likely to be subject to accidents. The possibility of opening the door to other power companies to store nuclear waste at the Goshute site is of major concern.

No one wants nuclear waste in their backyard, nor in our neighbor's backyard. Let's not dump nuclear waste in anyone's backyard. This waste needs to be stored near the plant that produced the waste. We need to look to the future for acceptable solutions in the production of this kind of waste product and the problems it produces. This scenario is a perfect example of benefit to a few at great expense to many.
