This letter relates to a matter discussed in a May 31, 2000, meeting on a possible high-level waste repository at Yucca Mountain, Nevada, between staff of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and the Department of Energy (DOE). At the meeting, the NRC staff undertook to clarify an applicant's responsibility for technical reports listed as references in a license application.

As a general matter, a license applicant is responsible for assuring that information provided in a license application is complete and accurate in all material respects. The applicant's responsibility extends to and includes any technical reports of a contractor that are listed as references in support of the application. In addition, any license application must be signed by the applicant or a duly authorized officer under oath or affirmation.

The DOE, of course, has not filed a license application for Yucca Mountain. However, we trust this letter will clarify the DOE's responsibility for the completeness and accuracy of information in the possible future event that it were to submit an application to the NRC.
