Dear Ms. Semerena:

We have reviewed the final Nebraska regulations for Control of Radiation-Ionizing (Title 180, Nebraska Administrative Code, Chapter 1), which became effective on May 27, 2000. The regulations were sent to NRC on September 26, 2000. We have also received two follow-up e-mails dated October 6 and October 11, 2000 from Ms. Cheryl K. Rogers. The final regulations are in response to the eight amendments identified in the enclosed Regulation Assessment Tracking System (RATS) Data Sheet. The regulations were reviewed by comparison to the equivalent NRC regulations in 10 CFR Part 20, 30, 32, 34, 71 and 150. In addition, we reviewed our letter dated May 19, 1999 to Ms. Rogers and our letter dated December 7, 1999 to you that addressed the proposed regulations. We also discussed our review of the regulations with you on December 4, 2000.

As a result of the NRC review we have identified one comment, as enclosed. This comment must be addressed to meet the compatibility and health and safety categories established in Office of State and Tribal Programs (STP) Procedure SA-200.

We have also summarized on the RATS Data Sheet our knowledge of the status of other Nebraska regulations. Please let us know if you note any inaccuracies or have any comments on the information contained in the RATS Data Sheet.

Also, it was noted that the word “within” is missing in the final regulation.</p> <p>A limited period of time, e.g., within 1 year for the licensee to submit information and within 2 years for the State agency to approve the submittals after the effective date of these regulations, should be specified to meet the compatibility category.</p>
