## SYNOPSIS

This investigation was initiated by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Office of Investigations (OI), Region IV (RIV), on June 2, 1999, to determine if a building operator at Entergy Operations, Inc.'s (EOI) Grand Gulf Nuclear Station (GGNS) was the subject of employment discrimination for reporting possible exam compromise to management.

Based on the evidence developed during the investigation, the allegation that a building operator at EOI's GGNS was discriminated against for reporting safety concerns to management was not substantiated.
