SUBJECT: CALLAWAY PLANT, UNIT 1 - CLARIFICATION OF  
APPLICATION TO ELIMINATE BORON DILUTION MITIGATION  
SYSTEM (TAC NO. MA9065)

Attached is an e-mail from the licensee that clarifies the application dated May 25, 2000, that requested the elimination of the boron dilution mitigation system (BDMS) from the technical specifications (TSs). The e-mail dated January 26, 2001, explains that the TS Table of Contents that lists the BDMS TSs and the page number should be replaced with the word "Deleted." Because the licensee proposed to delete TS 3.3.9, "Boron Dilution Mitigation System (BDMS)," and its associated Bases, the Table of Contents should also reflect the proposed elimination. I discussed this by phone with Al Passwater, Manager of Licensing and Fuels at Callaway, on January 29, 2001, and was informed that the attached e-mail dated January 26, 2001, was the change to the Table of Contents requested by the licensee.

The change to the TS Table of Contents is an administrative change that results from the proposed change in the licensee's application of May 25, 2000, and does not revise any requirements in the TSs that are not revised by the application.
