Dear Mr. Blind:

By letter dated June 2, 2000, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (Con Edison) submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) its Revision 2 to the Indian Point Unit No. 2 (IP2) Inservice Testing (IST) Program Summary for Pumps and Valves. The program is applicable for the third 10-year IST interval which covers the period from July 1, 1994 through May 18, 2005. In a letter dated November 28, 1997, Con Edison had committed to the NRC to re-evaluate the IST program selection criteria document and review the need to revise the IST program scope. In its June 2 letter, Con Edison stated that the program review was performed in accordance with the requirements of American Society of Mechanical Engineers/American National Standards Institute (ASME/ANSI) Standard OMa-1998, Addenda to ASME/ANSI OM-1987, Parts 6 and 10, and that Revision 2 to the IST Program Summary identifies the components which were added or deleted from the program.

The NRC staff has conducted a brief review of the IP2 IST Program Summary and finds that it includes no relief requests or proposed alternatives that require NRC review and approval. Thus, the NRC staff has determined that a complete review of Revision 2 to the IST program is not necessary.
