Re: Expedited/emergency FOIA request for information necessary to Atomic Safety Licensing Board proceeding on CT Yankee's License Termination Plan.

Dear FOIA/Privacy Act Officer:

By this letter I am making a FOIA request to the US Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). This request needs to be handled on an emergency or expedited basis. I am the duly authorized representative of the Citizens Awareness Network (CAN). CAN is a nonprofit, educational organization recognized as 501 (c)(3) tax exempt. CAN has petitioned for a hearing. The commission has assembled an Atomic Safety Licensing Board hearing panel. A filing deadline for our contentions has been set for February 26th, 2001. We need the following information that our expert has told us is in the possession of your agency:

All NRC Region 1 or NRC on-site data regarding alpha contamination soil sampling plans and results since 1998 for the CT Yankee nuclear reactor.

The requested information will not only assist CAN in the preparation in its contentions in this case, but will also provide the board and the general public, through CAN's educational mission in promulgating such activities, with otherwise unavailable and important material on serious radioactive contamination at the CT Yankee nuclear power station site.

I realize that there is little time for you to meet this request, however this is a matter of importance, and we are very certain that only a small number of documents will be found to satisfy this request as it is quite specific.

Thank you again in advance for your efforts and kind cooperation.
