SUBJECT: MEETING WITH STRATEGIC TEAMING AND RESOURCE SHARING -
INTEGRATED REGULATORY AFFAIRS GROUP FOR THE LICENSEES OF
CALLAWAY, COMANCHE PEAK, DIABLO CANYON, SOUTH TEXAS, AND
WOLF CREEK (TAC NO. MB0265)

A meeting was held on Wednesday, February 7, 2001, between the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff and the licensees for the above facilities. The meeting was held at the request of the Strategic Teaming and Resource Sharing - Integrated Regulatory Affairs Group (STARS-IRAG) that has been formed by the licensees. The IRAG is a group within STARS to interact with the staff on common regulatory issues for the facilities. The goal of STARS-IRAG is to reduce the overall costs of licensing actions to the licensees and the staff by developing common licensing action requests. The notice for the meeting was issued on October 20, 2000. This is the third meeting of the staff with the STARS-IRAG. The meeting summaries for the previous two meetings were issued on September 1 and December 1, 2000.

Attached is a list of the meeting attendees. The handout provided by the licensees at the meeting may be found in ADAMS under the accession number ML01039221. The staff did not provide a handout at the meeting. There was no discussion of any current licensing actions under staff review for any of the above facilities. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the risk-informed inservice inspections (ISIs) for the facilities.

Available under accession number ML01039221 are the following items provided by the licensees: (1) the agenda for the meeting, (2) background for the STARS-IRAG, (3) slides on the content of the ISI submittals and the projected submittal dates, and (4) draft submittals for Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station and Wolf Creek Generating Station. The two draft submittals are not requests for relief from 10 CFR 50.55a on codes and standards. The requests for relief will be submitted for all five plants on or about February 15, 2001.

The purpose of the meeting was for the licensees to explain that there will be joint submittals for the five plants requesting relief from Section XI examination requirements of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code for ISI of Class 1 and 2 piping welds and to present the risk-informed ISI process that was used to develop the

submittals. The submittals from the five licensees are based on the same risk-informed ISI process which is discussed in Section 3 of both of the draft submittals. The licensees explained that all plant-specific information in the submittals is identified in brackets (i.e., [...]), and all information without brackets is common to all the plants. There will be five submittals, one from each plant.

The staff reviewed and discussed the contents of the two draft submittals. Based on this discussion, the licensees may provide additional information in their formal submittals.

The licensees completed their presentation and the meeting was closed.
