Catherine,

Per our earlier discussion, the Office of the Chief Information Officer concurs in the subject rulemaking based on the change to section 32.52(c) that clarifies that the records to be kept are supportive of the transfer reports, and not the reports themselves. I also suggest that you review the public comments/NRC responses to ensure that you have worded the information in a manner that will decrease the probability for comments from the Commissioners' reviewers. Some of the language is rather confusing and difficult to follow. However, as indicated via written communication from me to you and, as stated in the rulemaking package, the final rule cannot be published until after OMB has approved the information collections contained in the rule.

I promised to have my comments to you by today for discussion by tomorrow. Unfortunately, the budget review, which was not on my calendar until this morning, lasted into the early afternoon, and I was unable to complete my review. I will get the info to you tomorrow.
