## **EFFECTIVENESS EVALUATION**

### **Fitness For Duty Program Performance Data**

Random testing is performed at an annual rate of at least 50% of the workforce in accordance with 10 CFR 26.24(a)(2). The current six month reporting period random testing rate was approximately 33.5%. There were 951 random tests conducted with an average of 2839 workers eligible for testing. The annual testing rate was approximately 58.0% with 1708 random tests conducted with an average of 2947 workers eligible for testing.

For this reporting period, the total rate of positive test results for this reporting period was approximately 0.58%. There were 7 positive results out of 1211 tests. The positive test results were comprised of 6 pre-access, 1 random, 0 for-cause, and 0 other. For the year, the total rate of positive results was approximately 0.53%. There were 16 positive test results out of 3042 tests. The annual positive test results were comprised of 13 pre-access, 2 random, 0 for-cause, and 1 other. Unescorted access for the individuals with confirmed positive tests was denied or revoked, as applicable.

For this reporting period, the positive test rate for employees was 0.00%, with 0 positive results out of 766 tests. For this reporting period, the positive test rate for contractors was approximately 1.57%, with 7 positive results out of 445 tests.

For the year, the positive test rate for employees was 0.00% with 0 positive test results out of 1397 tests. For the year, the positive test rate for contractors was approximately 0.97%, with 16 positive results out of 1645 tests.

There were no identified abuses of over-the-counter or prescription medication during the reporting period.

There were no unsatisfactory blind performance tests during the reporting period.

## **EVENTS REPORTED TO THE NRC**

### Events Reported By Telephone Under 10 CFR 26.73

On July 5, 2000, CP&L made a 24-hour report to the NRC identifying a licensed operator who admitted that an illegal controlled substance had been used on several occasions during the recent past. Although licensed, the subject individual's license was inactive and he had not performed any licensed duties during the periods disclosed during the investigation. The operator was subsequently denied access.
