

Follow up on Technical issued identified during routine inspection at Maryland QC Laboratories on January 12, 2001.

On February 15, 2001, I spoke with Dave Tiktinsky in SFPO. He is the project manager for issues involving OP-660 and OPL-660 Type B packages. He stated that he had been in contact with AEA Technology/QSA regarding the ammo box that was returned to them by Maryland QC. Mr. Tiktinsky indicated that an AEA representative indicated that the damage to the ammo box may have been caused when the latches were closed after a misalignment of the lid of the box. The AEA representative indicated that they have only had a few ammo boxes returned with damage (not necessarily similar damage) and that they do not view the problem that Maryland QC experienced with the latches to be a widespread problem. Mr. Tiktinsky indicated that SFPO plans no further follow up on this issue.
