Pending NRC Actions Requested for Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant

REFERENCE: (a) Letter from Mr. A. W. Dromerick (NRC) to Mr. R. E. Denton (BGE), dated June 30, 2000, Order Approving the Transfer of Renewed Facility Operating Licenses for Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant and the Materials License for Calvert Cliffs Independent Spent fuel Storage Installation from Baltimore Gas and Electric Company to Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant, Inc. and Conforming Amendments (TAC Nos. MA8343, MA8344, and L23060)

Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant, Inc. (CCNPPI) hereby requests the NRC to treat pending actions requested by Baltimore Gas and Electric Company (BGE) prior to July 1, 2000, as requests made by CCNPPI.

By letter dated June 30, 2000 (Reference a), the NRC issued Amendment Nos. 237, 211, and 2 for the licenses for Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant Units 1 and 2, and the Calvert Cliffs Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation, respectively. These amendments reflect the transfer of the licenses from BGE to CCNPPI.

A number of actions associated with these licenses were pending with the NRC at the time of the license transfers. Baltimore Gas and Electric Company sought requested actions as holder of these licenses before the transfer. Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant, Inc. hereby adopts such requested actions made by BGE prior to the license transfers, and requests that the NRC treat them in all respects as if made by CCNPPI. Further, CCNPPI requests that current pending activities and correspondence reflect the license transfers.
