As discussed in the November 1, 1999 telephone conversation between Richard Conte and Steve Reininghaus, we are requesting the Nine Mile Point Unit 2 Initial License Exam, originally scheduled for the week of December 6, 1999, be rescheduled for the week of February 14, 2000. We are also requesting the Nine Mile Point Unit 1 Initial License Exam be rescheduled for the first available date after April 1, 2000.


This request for delay is based on the self-identification of program implementation deficiencies. Specifically this involves the tasks selected for training vs. actual training conducted. We have scheduled the following corrective actions:

- An independent assessment will be conducted to ensure all programmatic issues are identified;
- The lesson materials to complete the program requirements will be developed;
- The class schedules will be revised to support the additional training.

Additionally, we have determined that no adverse effects exist relating to the Unit 2 Initial Exam Sample Plan.
