SUBJECT: STOLEN PORTABLE GAUGE

DESCRIPTION:

On March 2, 2001, the Nevada State Health Division (NSHD) notified the NRC's Operations Center by facsimile of a stolen portable gauge. The NSHD was informed by Delta Geotechnical Consultants, Inc., a Utah based corporation operating in Nevada under reciprocity, that a Troxler Model 3430 portable gauge (Serial No. 25510) containing a 296 megabequerel (8 millicuries) cesium-137 source and a 1480 megabequerel (40 millicuries) americium-241/beryllium source, was stolen out of their company truck while parked overnight at a local motel in Las Vegas, Nevada. The licensee informed NSHD that the gauge was chained to the truck bed. The gauge was last seen at 2300 PST on March 1, 2001. At 0700 PST on March 2, 2001, the authorized user discovered that the chain had been cut and the gauge had been stolen. The licensee promptly reported the theft to the Las Vegas Metro Police.

The NSHD has notified the State of Utah.

Region IV received notification of this occurrence from NRC's Operations Center. Region IV has informed the OEDO, NMSS, OSTP, IAT and Region IV's SLO and PAO.

This information has been discussed with the State and is current as of 11:00 a.m. CST on March 5, 2001.
