Harding ESE is pleased to submit to you two copies of the Derived Concentration Guideline Level (DCGL) Report for the former Watertown Arsenal GSA Property, Watertown, Massachusetts. Additional copies of the document have been distributed in accordance with the distribution list below.

DCGLs are site-specific concentrations determined to be protective of the health of individuals that might be exposed in the future to the residual radioactivity that might be left in place on the site. The DCGLs have been calculated to meet requirements set by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), the Massachusetts Department of Public Health (MADPH), and the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MADEP).
