FRom our review of the license two issues have come up:

First, to specify that possession of the special nuclear material (Pu) you create is allowed but not separation we would propose to add a B(2)f. that says: "Such special nuclear material as may be produced by the operation of the reactor. The licensee is not authorized to separate this special nuclear material."

Second, to allow you to separate byproduct material for experimental purposes we would propose an addition of a parenthetical phrase to item in B(3)(4) to read "to possess, but not to separate (except for byproduct material produced as allowed for experiments), such byproduct material as may be produced by the operation of the reactor."

Can you please review and comment to my by COB 3/8/01. Thanks
