Dear Dr. Hilleboe:

In accordance with the procedure agreed upon at our meeting in July with representatives of the State Governments, this is to inform you that the Atomic Energy Commission on January 31, 1956 issued a Special Nuclear Material license to the Nuclear Development Corporation of America, 5 New Street, White Plains, New York.

The license authorizes the Corporation to receive and possess five hundred (500) grams of uranium enriched to a maximum of 30% in the isotope U-235 for use in the conduct of research upon effects of reactor-produced radiation upon simulated nuclear reactor fuel elements. The licensee is further authorized to receive and possess the by-product material and special nuclear material which will be produced through irradiation in the Materials Testing Reactor, Arco, Idaho, of samples of encapsulated special nuclear material.

As a condition of the license the licensee shall conduct no activity with respect to irradiated special nuclear material received under the license other than that necessary to the storage of such material at 5 New Street, White Plains, New York, in accordance with storage procedures. Upon approval of the applicant's hot cell facility the licensee will be authorized by the Commission to proceed with specified activities with respect to the irradiated special nuclear material. You will be notified when such action is taken.

This license was issued after a determination by the Commission that the applicant's facilities, experience, and proposed procedures are adequate to protect health and to minimize danger to life or property.
