Dear Mr. Johnson:

Confirming our conversation of this date, we here-
with amend our former application, dated October 6, 1955,
for Special Nuclear Material in the following respects:

Instead of two thousand grams of uranium enriched with
U-235 to a maximum of 30% by weight, the application is here-
by changed to five hundred grams of uranium with the same
degree of enrichment.

We understand that this amount will remove the possibi-
lity of a criticality hazard. At a future date it is our
intention to increase the amount to that originally requested.
Our present needs would be taken care of by the five hundred
gram quantity.

We would appreciate anything you can do to hasten the
granting of a license for this amount as some of our present
programs are being delayed.
