On March 9, 2001, the NRC completed a baseline inspection at your Fermi 2 Nuclear Power Plant. The enclosed report presents the results of that inspection. The results of this inspection were discussed on March 9, 2001 with Mr. A. Kowalczyk, Nuclear Support Manager, and members of your staff.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to Safeguards Strategic Performance Area and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. Within these areas the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations of activities, and interviews with personnel. Specifically, this inspection focused on your response plan, defensive strategy, and relevant implementing procedures and practices.

Based on the results of this inspection, no findings of significance were identified.
