Dear Mr. Lee:

I am pleased to extend this official invitation to Dr. Seung Haeng Lee to be temporarily assigned to the staff of the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for a four-month period beginning Monday, March 5, 2001. Dr. Lee, an employee of the Korea Institute of Nuclear Safety (KINS), will be assigned to the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation (NRR), the Emergency Preparedness and Radiation Protection Section of the Division of Inspection Program Management (DIPM), Operator Licensing Human Performance and Plant Support Branch (IOLB). During this assignment, Dr. Lee will participate in routine Health Physics (HP) activities including Events Review, Revised Reactor Oversight Program performance indicators and inspection issues and assist in technical oversight of ongoing rulemaking and regulatory guide development. He will also have three weeks classroom training.

In addition to extending this invitation, I would like this letter to serve as a memorandum of the following understandings governing certain administrative aspects of the assignment.

1. Dr. Lee will engage in activities essentially similar to those engaged in by NRC employees, without any special "diverse experience" assignments except those that might be convenient to the NRC.
2. All salary, allowances, assignment-related travel costs (including costs of such travel within the U.S.), liability, and responsibility for Dr. Lee will be assumed by KINS.
3. The assignment will be for a period of four months. However, this assignment may be terminated prior to the expiration of such period or extended for an additional period.
4. KINS affirms that Dr. Lee is a permanent employee of the Korea Institute of Nuclear Safety and will retain the employment relationship during his assignment to the NRC, and recommends him for this assignment.
