We have received the enclosed Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Region V final exercise report, dated March 19, 2001, for the December 5, 2000 plume exposure pathway exercise at the Point Beach Nuclear Power Plant.

No deficiencies and one area requiring corrective action were identified by FEMA Region V staff regarding the performances of State and county officials in Wisconsin.
