We have received the enclosed Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) correspondence dated January 26, 2001, transmitting the FEMA final exercise report for the October 18, 2000, full-scale emergency planning zone exercise at the Duane Arnold Energy Center.

No deficiencies were identified during the exercise. However, three Areas Requiring Corrective Action (ARCA) were identified and subsequently corrected during the exercise and closed.

We fully recognize that any corrective actions to be implemented may involve parties and political institutions which are not under your direct control. Nonetheless, we expect that assistance, if appropriate, will be extended.
