Dear Mr. Stello:

I received your correspondence of January 22, 1981 referencing our NRC license #31-00461-10 for tritium buttons used in non-agreement states. Results of personnel monitoring in statistical summary form were requested. Eastman Kodak Company has retrieved all tritium buttons from all processing laboratories outside Rochester, New York. Thus, NRC licensing is no longer required for these items. Personnel monitoring was not necessary for these tritium buttons, thus monitoring results cannot be reported. Since this license is no longer needed we would like to cancel it; otherwise the license will expire June 30, 1983 and will not be renewed. Your cooperation is appreciated in this matter.
